ARCHIVES OF GERMAN – JEWISH SCHOLARSHIP

In 2018, the Hebrew University celebrates 100 years since the laying of its cornerstone. More than any other research institute, the Hebrew University embodies the complex interactions between science and politics in the twentieth century, a period shaped by conflicts and tensions.

To mark this occasion, the German Literature Archive Marbach together with the Hebrew University will explore the history of a century of German-Jewish culture and research. This includes the opening of the Hebrew University's Historical Archive (1918 – 1948) as well as of a number of important historical documents held in Israel, to which the international research community previously had only very limited access and which were made available within the framework of two major research projects in the past years.

Prominent examples from the Historical Archive and from the holdings of the Staatsbibliothek zu Berlin will be on display.
